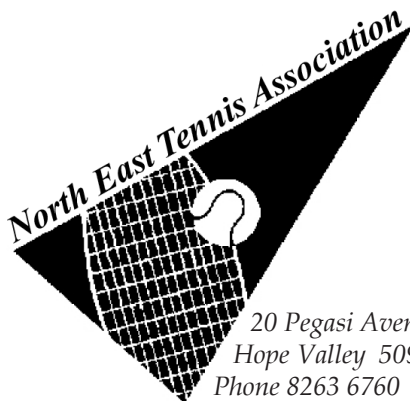
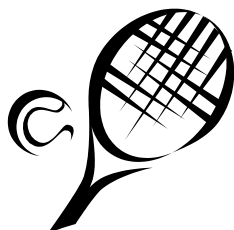

WEDNESDAY COMPETITION MATCH RULES

1 REGISTRATION

- a) All clubs may call on reserve players from other clubs for a maximum of three matches, those players are not eligible for finals for the proxy club.
- b) No player may fill two positions for any club on the same day.
- c) No Primary or Secondary school children may play in the Midweek Ladies Competition. (This defines the meaning 'midweek ladies competition'.)
- d) The top four ranked players in any State League Tennis Team shall not be allowed to play in this competition.

2 MATCH PLAY

- a) Teams may optionally consist of up to 6 ladies for any team on any one day including finals.
- b) Matches shall consist of doubles only. The tie-break system will apply at 6 games all in the three sets. A list of ranking order of 4, 5 or 6 players must be submitted before start of play. Player combinations for each rotation are determined prior to the start of each rotation.
- c) Players may umpire their own set.
- d) A member of the home team shall toss/spin to decide the choice of service or end.
- e) Matches commence at 9.15am, all players must be present by 9.30am to participate in the match. Penalties may be imposed by the opposition team.
- f) Any team may forfeit sets with no penalty to lower divisions. The forfeit must be at the number 4 position.

3 SCORING AND FORFEITS

- a) The winning team will be awarded 4 premiership points for a win plus 1 premiership point for each set won. In the event of a draw, 2 premiership point will be awarded to each team plus 1 point for each set won.
- b) If a team forfeits, the team receiving the forfeit shall be registered as having played, provided that a list of the team has been forwarded to the Score Steward in accordance with rule 10(a) they shall receive 10 premiership points.
- c) Any team recording false scores will receive no premiership points and may be liable to be fined.

4 TENNIS BALLS

Association approved tennis balls only to be used. New balls to be used for each weekly match.

5 ORDER OF MERIT

- a) Any club shall have up to and including 3 matches to settle the position of players in the teams. After that date, players shall play in accordance with rule 5(b).
- b) Where there are no absentees or incoming players, players may be moved up or down no more than 1 ranking position from the position they played in the previous match in minor rounds only. Penalty: loss of sets involving infringing players.
- c) Any player from a lower division may play in a higher division.

6 TWO TEAMS IN ANY ONE DIVISION

- a) Either team is permitted to use the strongest reserve/s available.
- b) Any nominated player in any team in the same division may play for their other team in that division provided they play in their current order of merit.

7 TEAM LIST FOR FINALS

- a) Prior to finals, each club shall submit a ranking list of all teams in finals.
- b) The list shall be in the hands of the Score Steward on the Friday before the first match of the major round.
- c) Players to be played strictly as ranked for finals. Penalty: forfeit of the match.
- d) Results of the last match of minor round and results of all major round matches to be in the hands of the Score Steward on the same day.
- e) In the event of a draw during finals, 2 nominated players from each team shall play a **SUPER** tie break. Match tie break is first to 10 points with an advantage of 2 points.

8 ELIGIBILITY FOR FINALS

- a) To be eligible for finals, a player must play 9 sets for that team during the season. To be eligible for a lower division final, a player must play a total of 9 sets in that division or lower, except in extenuating circumstances the mid week committee may grant permission.
- b) No player may fill two positions for any club on the same day.

9. UNFINISHED FINAL ROUNDS

In the event of the all finals not reaching a decision for any reason, the team who finished higher at the end of the minor round shall be declared the winner.

10 INCLEMENT WEATHER

- a) Both captains to decide at 9.45am whether too wet to roll. Once play has commenced if there is an interruption during play, players are to wait a period of 20 minutes before both captains decide if it is too wet to continue play or to sweep the courts. There is no enforcement of a forfeit for the incomplete sets if the weather is too wet to continue, therefore a washout would be declared by both captains.

In the event of extreme storm weather warnings and there is no possibility of match play, the captains of teams can contact each other to cancel the match. No player can be forced to play if conditions are unsafe.

- b) Every match is to be played to a finish unless abandoned with the consent of the captains of both competition teams. If a majority of matches are played then all results stand. If a majority do not play then each team will be awarded 2 premiership points. A match has been decided if either team is in an unbeatable position.
- c) If the estimated temperature as forecast on radio station 5AA at 8.00am on match day is 36 degrees or higher then matches are to be automatically cancelled.

11 MATCH RESULTS

- a) The 'Home' team shall have the results of the match in the hands of the Score Steward by Friday following the match.
- b) If a home team fails to send in score sheets by the Friday following the match, they shall be penalised 2 premiership points from their total points.
- c) The 'Winning' team shall give the score sheet to the Score Steward for all finals matches.

12 INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES

- a) All disputes shall be referred to the Permit Committee in writing.
- b) Any contravening of these rules will be referred to the Permit Committee who may impose a forfeit on the offending teams.
- c) Any situation not covered by these rules shall be referred to the Senior Saturday Competition Rules.
